

# 4 Day Cairo And Alexandria Wheelchair Accessible Tour

📍 Cairo, Egypt



This 4 day Cairo and Alexandria wheelchair accessible tour stays in Cairo for three nights and includes a private Mediterranean day trip. An adapted van, sightseeing helper and portage are provided, but the Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa involve access conditions that may not suit a wheelchair user and must be reviewed before the itinerary is sold.

## Tour Itinerary

**Day 1 : Arrival in Cairo and Dinner Cruise**

Meet the representative at Cairo International Airport and transfer by adapted private van to the hotel. In the evening, use the confirmed boarding arrangement for the Nile dinner cruise, enjoy the scheduled meal and entertainment, then return to the hotel.

## **Day 2 : Giza and Cairo Museums**

Visit the wheelchair-suitable viewpoints agreed in advance at the Giza Plateau for the Great Pyramid, Great Sphinx and Valley Temple. Continue to the Grand Egyptian Museum, have lunch and tour the accessible galleries of the Egyptian Museum in Tahrir Square before returning to the hotel.

## **Day 3 : Alexandria Day Trip**

Drive to Alexandria and visit the Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa only if the traveler-specific access plan has been confirmed. Continue to Pompey's Pillar and Qaitbay Citadel, have a seafood lunch and finish at the Bibliotheca Alexandrina before returning to Cairo.

## **Day 4 : Departure from Cairo**

Have breakfast and transfer to Cairo International Airport in the adapted vehicle. The representative assists with luggage and departure formalities before the onward flight.
