Tour Itinerary

Day 1 : Start your Cruise & Visit Aswan Highlights

Your cruise begins in Aswan with the advanced Aswan High Dam, the bedrock-attached The Unfinished

Obelisk of Hatshepsut, and the divine Philae Temple, honoring Isis with the tale of Osiris and Horus on its walls. You then transfer to your 5-star deluxe Nile cruise for lunch, dinner, and the overnight on board.

Day 2 : Discover Abu Simbel & Sail to Kom Ombo

An early start brings you to the colossal Abu Simbel Temples, guardian of the southern borders built by Ramses the Great to honor his win at the Battle of Kadesh and his wife Queen Nefertari. You then return to your cruise for lunch and dinner and begin sailing toward Kom Ombo for the overnight on board.

Day 3 : Trip to Kom Ombo & Edfu Temples

A guided trip visits the grand double Kom Ombo Temple honoring the two gods Sobek and Haroeris and revealing ancient medical tools, then, reached by horse carriage, the highly preserved Edfu Temple of Horus built where he defeated Set. You continue cruising to Luxor through Esna, arriving late at night for the overnight on board.

Day 4 : Enjoy Luxor Treasures & End Your 3 Nights Nile Cruise from Aswan

After checking out, you explore Luxor's Valley of the Kings with its 63 tombs of rulers like Ramses II and Tutankhamun, the classical Hatshepsut Temple designed by Senenmut, and the quartzite Colossi of Memnon of Amenhotep III. After lunch you visit the magical Karnak Temple of the Theban triad, ending your 3-night Nile cruise from Aswan.
