

5 Day Cairo, Aswan And Abu Simbel Wheelchair Tour

📍 Cairo, Egypt



This 5 day Cairo Aswan and Abu Simbel wheelchair tour combines two Cairo sightseeing days with one night in Aswan and an early road trip to the Nubian temples. A wheelchair-adapted private van, sightseeing helper and portage are included, but Philae's boat crossing and the long Abu Simbel visit require traveler-specific access planning.

Tour Itinerary

Day 1 : Arrival in Cairo and Dinner Cruise

Meet the representative at Cairo International Airport for help with arrival procedures and transfer by adapted van to the hotel. In the evening, join the dinner cruise only with the confirmed accessible boarding arrangement, then return to the hotel.

Day 2 : Giza and Cairo Museums

Follow the prearranged wheelchair route at the Giza Plateau for views of the Great Pyramid, Great Sphinx and Valley Temple. Continue to the Grand Egyptian Museum, have lunch and tour the accessible galleries of the Egyptian Museum in Tahrir Square before returning to the hotel.

Day 3 : Fly to Aswan and Tour the City

Fly to Aswan and begin at the High Dam using the confirmed vehicle access. Continue to the ancient granite quarry for the unfinished obelisk, then have lunch. Use the prebooked boat and assistance plan for Philae Temple before checking in at the Aswan hotel.

Day 4 : Abu Simbel and Flight to Cairo

Leave Aswan early with the arranged breakfast box and travel by adapted private vehicle to Abu Simbel. Follow the access route confirmed for the traveler's chair at the temples of Ramesses II and Queen Nefertari. Return to Aswan for lunch, fly to Cairo and transfer to the hotel.

Day 5 : Departure from Cairo

Have breakfast and travel by adapted van to Cairo International Airport. The representative assists with luggage and departure procedures before the homeward flight.
