Tour Itinerary

Day 1 : Witness the Ancient Civilization in Luxor City

This Easter Nile cruise opens on Luxor's East Bank at the divine Karnak Temple, the New Kingdom's religious capital dedicated to the Theban triad of Amun, Mut, and Khonsu. After lunch and relaxation aboard the Oberoi Zahra, the evening brings Luxor Temple by Night, whose columns come alive under the moonlight. Dinner and the overnight are on board the cruise.

Day 2 : Discover the Hidden Treasures of the Ancient Kings

The day explores Luxor's West Bank, beginning in the Valley of the Kings, the New Kingdom necropolis holding 63 royal tombs including Tutankhamun and Seti I. It continues to the mortuary Hatshepsut Temple, honoring the great queen and the god Amun, then the towering Colossi of Memnon, the paired statues of Amenhotep III. Lunch and dinner are aboard the cruise as it sails toward Edfu.

Day 3 : Witness the Beauty of Edfu & Kom Ombo Temples

After breakfast, guests visit the beautifully preserved Edfu Temple, dedicated to the falcon god Horus and built to narrate his mythic battle with Set. The cruise then sails to the Kom Ombo Temple, the double sanctuary honoring the crocodile god Sobek and Horus the Elder, noted for its depictions of ancient medicine and astronomy. Lunch, dinner, and a late-night arrival in Aswan follow on board.

Day 4 : Lose Yourself Down the Charm of Aswan

Aswan's highlights fill the day, starting with the Aswan High Dam, the 1960s engineering marvel that tamed the Nile's floods. Next comes The Unfinished Obelisk, Hatshepsut's colossal 42-meter monument abandoned in the bedrock after it cracked, followed by the graceful Philae Temple dedicated to Isis. Meals and the overnight are aboard the cruise.

Day 5 : End Your Easter Nile River Cruise Holiday

After breakfast and check-out, guests are transferred anywhere within Aswan, bringing the Egypt Easter Nile cruise holiday to a close. It is a relaxed farewell to five days of sailing and sightseeing.
