

7 Day Cairo, Luxor And Hurghada Family Tour

Tour Itinerary

Day 1 : Arrival in Cairo

Meet the airport representative, complete the arrival formalities and transfer privately to your Cairo

hotel. Have dinner and keep the evening free to settle in before the sightseeing begins.

Day 2 : Giza Pyramids, Camel Ride and Flight to Luxor

Visit the pyramids of Khufu, Khafre and Menkaure, the Great Sphinx and Valley Temple. Take a guided camel ride, stop for lunch and then tour the Grand Egyptian Museum. Fly to Luxor and transfer to your hotel.

Day 3 : Karnak and Luxor Temple by Night

Explore Karnak Temple and its monumental courts and columned halls. After lunch and time to rest, return to the East Bank sightseeing route for illuminated Luxor Temple. Spend the second night in Luxor, as stated by the day sequence.

Day 4 : Luxor West Bank, School Visit and Transfer to Hurghada

Enter selected tombs in the Valley of the Kings, then visit Hatshepsut Temple and the Colossi of Memnon. After lunch, meet local students if the school schedule permits. Continue by private vehicle to Hurghada and check in at the resort.

Day 5 : Free Day in Hurghada

Enjoy a full free day at the resort. Families can relax beside the Red Sea, use the hotel facilities or arrange optional gentle water activities independently.

Day 6 : Flight from Hurghada to Cairo

Have breakfast, check out and transfer to Hurghada Airport. Fly to Cairo, meet the representative on arrival and continue to your hotel for the final night.

Day 7 : Departure from Cairo

Have breakfast and check out. Transfer to Cairo Airport and receive assistance with departure before the family's onward flight.
